Article of the Month

Beckie, H.J., Hall, L.M, Shirriff, S.W., Martin, E and Leeson, J.Y., 2019. **Glyphosate and acetolactate synthase inhibitor resistance in Russian thistle (*Salsola tragus L.*) in Alberta.** Can. J. Plant Sci. 99: 384-387.

Abstract: A survey was conducted in Alberta in 2017 to determine the distribution and abundance of acetolactate synthase (ALS) inhibitor and glyphosate resistance in Russian thistle. Of 45 populations tested, 31 (62%) were ALS inhibitor resistant. No populations exhibited resistance to glyphosate. This survey serves as a baseline to monitor future incidence of resistance in this weed.
