In Memorium: Dr. Linda Hall



It is with sadness that the CWSS informs the membership of the passing of Dr. Linda Hall. Dr. Hall was a Fellow and former President of the Canadian Weed Science Society, a graduate student supervisor, colleague, mentor and friend to many of our members. She received her Ph.D. from the University of Saskatchewan and completed a post-doctoral fellowship in Australia. Dr. Hall worked for Alberta Agriculture and then settled at the University of Alberta. She retired in 2019 as a full professor from the University of Alberta. In her time at the university, she supervised numerous graduate students, both M.Sc. and Ph.D., and was also active on supervisory committees or as a co-supervisor for many more. She was a gifted and sought-after extension speaker due to her ability to tell a story, connect with her audience and convey complicated scientific principals in terms that anyone could understand. Linda was a scientist who was curious about everything. This led her research program to cover everything from weed biology, herbicide management, and transgenic biosafety, to agronomics like plant growth regulators and soil fertility. Dr. Hall's research program was world renowned and her contributions to the fields of weed science, herbicide resistance and transgenic biosafety helped put Western Canada on the map and helped countless growers to manage their operations more sustainably. She was a bundle of energy and that energy didn't slow down after she retired. Instead, she channeled it into artistic and active pursuits including gardening, hiking, quilting and kayaking. Her passion, her laughter, her mentorship and her friendship will be sorely missed.
